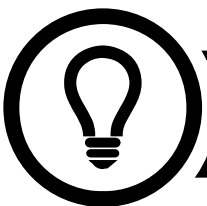

To request public shelter assistance, please call Coordinated Intake at the number above between 8am-8pm Monday through Friday to complete an assessment.

**\*Coordinated Intake guarantees access to shelter. You do not need to go to Coordinated Intake for the following private shelters, but there is not guaranteed access.\***

If you are requesting shelter after hours or on a weekend:

Men go to 2100 Lakeside; Women go to 2227 Payne Ave (Norma Herr)

Families call 2-1-1 or use the callbox at the Coordinated Intake site to get a shelter bed.

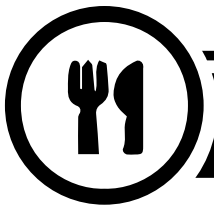
To access every publicly funded shelter in the community, you must complete a Coordinated Intake application.
