Coordinated Intake guarantees access to shelter. You do not need to go to Coordinated Intake for the following private shelters, but there is not guaranteed access

If you are requesting shelter after hours or on a weekend:

Men go to 2100 Lakeside; Women go to 2227 Payne Ave (Norma Herr) Families call 2-1-1 or use the callbox at the Coordinated Intake site to get a shelter bed. To access every publicly funded shelter in the community, you must complete a Coordinated Intake application. Referrals are made to places such as 2100 Lakeside, Norma Herr Women's Shelter, Y-Haven, Harbor Light, PASS, City Mission, Family Promise, and West Side Catholic Center's Moriah House from Coordinated Intake.
